It was built 1200 years ago to calm the eruption of Mt. Fuji, in accordance with the culture. We respect this centrally located and stately shrine as a symbol of our city.



The rain and snowfall on Mt. Fuji come up from the ground throughout Fujinomiya City after a long time. The water from Mt. Fuji is our source of life and gives many blessings, like agriculture, industry, trout cultivation, sake brewing, Japanese sweets and dyes. Wakutama pond in Fujisan Hongu Sengentaisha Shrine is very sacred and is conserved by our country. We enjoy the spring water everywhere in Fujinomiya City.
